

Cleaning before moving

When you move out, you need to hand over the dwelling empty, in good condition and cleaned, as you will otherwise need to pay a big cleaning fee. It is more pleasant for the next tenant to move into a new home when the dwelling has been cleaned.

All rooms

- wipe the cabinet shelves
- wipe the door handles and light switches
- vacuum and wipe the floors with a damp cloth, use water with detergent
- wash and dry windows at least from the inside (no need if you have done it regularly two times a year)

Kitchen

- clear and melt the refrigerator, wipe it with a damp cloth, use water with detergent
- unplug the refrigerator and leave its door open
- clean the oven and stove well
- clean the extractor fan filter
- wipe the wall behind the oven and refrigerator
- wipe table tops with a damp cloth, use water with detergent

Bathroom/sauna and toilet

- wipe the bathroom/sauna floors and walls with a damp cloth, use water with detergent
- clean the sauna benches with a soft cleaning brush, use water with detergent, then rinse with water
- clean the floor drain
- wash the toilet bowl and hand basin

Other

- if you have a storage cabinet, clear it and sweep the floor
- clear the balcony
- take garbage away
- leave your old dwelling's smoke detector in place, do not take it with you to your new dwelling
- check that your new home has a working smoke detector
- take the key to the owner of the dwelling or to the lessor
